**DIRECTIONS TO WHIMBRELS**

**From Plymouth**

Travel via Liskeard and Bodmin towards Wadebridge. DO NOT turn into Wadebridge on the Egloshayle road, but follow the A39. At the roundabout just North of the Council offices, turn left, towards the town centre. At the mini-roundabout turn right, signed to Port Isaac and Rock.

Follow this road over the little traffic light controlled bridge. After a couple of miles, turn left signed to Rock. Follow the road to the outskirts of Rock, then turn right, almost opposite Pityme Inn, signed to Trebetherick.

Follow the road for a couple of miles, and at the top of a hill, turn sharp left signed to Daymer Bay. There is a telephone box at the junction. \*Approximately 300 yards down the road, and second right with a sign for 'Grey Ladies' turn right on to an unmade track. Whimbrels is the second house after the large field on your right - the name is on the gate, and the house now has a fan trellis with a plant on the terrace.

**From Launceston**

Shortly after by-passing Launceston, follow the signs to North Cornwall, taking the A395. At Davidstow turn left on the A39, then after only a mile or so, turn right on a minor road signed to Delabole. Follow this road through Delabole, and by the Bicycle Museum, go effectively straight on past the Gaia Wind Farm.

Continue through Pendoggett and St. Endellion, and by the Wave 7 Gallery, turn right signed to Polzeath. Follow the signs to Polzeath, go through the village and up the hill the other side.

You will enter Trebetherick, and shortly after passing the village stores on your left, turn right by the telephone box, signed to Daymer Bay. Follow directions from \* above.

**From South and West Cornwall**

Make your way to Bodmin by the most convenient route, and then follow directions from Plymouth
